In celebration of Remembrance Day, we were honoured to welcome serving personnel from RNAS Yeovilton, Naval veterans, personnel from the Royal British Legion and Reverend Nick Clarke to take part in our whole school assembly.

The assembly focused on our connections with serving personnel, both past and present and what we, as individuals, can do to promote peaceful resolutions to conflict.

We heard about the work of the Royal British Legion and how our donations to them are helping both serving and veteran personnel and their families, we had a poem about the significance of the poppy and we heard from one of our 97 military students about what it is like to be the child of someone in the military.

Reverend Nick Clarke led our 2 minutes silence and spoke about the wider impacts of war. Students were incredibly respectful towards our visitors and of the occasion.



Ten students and two staff then attended the Remembrance parade at RNAS Yeovilton. The students in attendance all have parents who are currently serving or have in the recent past. They represented the school and their families beautifully.

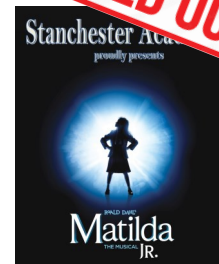
